Motion was made by Councilmember Tosta, seconded by Councilmember Bell, to adopt Ordinance No. 651 as amended and distributed to the City Council.

Direction/Action

Motion by Councilmember Berkowitz, seconded by Councilmember Tosta, to amend the motion to revise the ordinance title by adding "or Religion" after "Immigration Status," and adding a section to the ordinance stating "A. No Burien official, including any agent or contracted agent, may collect information or establish or otherwise utilize a registry, database, or similar for the purpose of classifying any person on the basis of religious affiliation, or conduct any study related to the collection of such information or the establishment or utilization of such a registry, database, or similar." and "B. Rule of construction. Nothing in this section may be construed as prohibiting the collection of information that is voluntarily provided, including relating to the decennial census."

Motion passed 4-3. Opposed Mayor Krakowiak, Deputy Mayor Edgar and Councilmember Wagner.

A vote was taken on the main motion as amended. **Motion** passed 4-3. Opposed, Mayor Krakowiak, Deputy Mayor Edgar and Councilmember Wagner.

Councilmembers reached consensus to move Business Agenda Item 4 "e" Discussion and Potential Action to Appoint Burien City Council Representatives to Local and Regional Governmental Organizations for 2017 to "f" Discussion Regarding Potential Partnership with the Quiet Skies Coalition for Purposes of Possible Litigation and reorder subsequent items.
