RESOLUTION NO. 364

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BURIEN, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW WHITE CENTER LIBRARY.

WHEREAS, KCLS plans to construct a new White Center library in the north Highline Unincorporated Area and the City of Seattle Potential Annexation Area; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Burien community that the new White Center library serve the community for the long term.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURIEN, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council requests the Board of Trustees of the King County Library System delay construction on the new White Center library until after an agreement is made with the City of Seattle for the library to remain open for the life of the building.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Burien City Council.
