Subject: # 34 in the Bicycle/Pedestrian Draft Plan; Specifically the Rationale and the Cost/Risk

In 2002 the city dealt with the issue of a trail development plan at 21st Ave SW and SW 146th Street. After considerable interaction between the citizens who live in the area and the city, the plans for this trail development were removed from the Seahurst Park Master Plan. Now the issue is again before the council as # 34 in the Subject Plan.

The rationale given two years ago was that the trail development would serve the local residents. Later, in the fall of 2002 after citizen input, former Mayor Woo indicated that because the local residents do not want it, the trail development plans should be deleted from the Seahurst Park Master Plan. And it was.

Now the rationale for this trail development is that # 34 would provide a link from Seahurst Park trails to Eagle Landing Park trail and Lake Burien School Park. Please consider:

- 1) These links already exist, and # 34 would add very little value as a link.
- 2) # 34 would be costly and risky

1) – There are existing pleasant residential streets between these locations. The desirability of these streets as walking routes is evidenced every day by large numbers of walkers. These residential streets provide safety because they have little vehicular traffic and they are not through a secluded and isolated area. (Seahurst Park neighbors know of several bad things that occur in the secluded isolated areas of the park.) The large numbers of walkers on these open-view streets enhance the security of the home owners along these streets. The streets are less strenuous to walk than a steep trail. It would take only about ten minutes longer to walk between the steep trail at Eagle Landing and another steep trail in Seahurst Park. (How many Burien residents would hike one steep trail, and then walk a quarter mile through a residential area to hike another steep trail through similar terrain? It is hard to visualize even one individual that would be so motivated.) Most of the walkers in this part of Burien are not seeking steep hiking areas. The hearty individuals that are surely wouldn't mind walking five or ten minutes to reach it. There is no logical rationale to justify # 34 as a "Link" as stated in the subject plan. The grant seekers on the council and in the city staff should not embarrass the city with this sophistry and publish it in an official city plan.

2) – In addition to acquisition costs, there would be high costs associated with trail development and maintenance in this area. The development costs would be due to geological features and environmental protection constraints. The city hall counter map identifies the entire Brown Property as "Landslide + Steepslopes (>40%)". There is more refined geological information in the Seahurst Park Master Plan. This parcel is very steep on the east and west sides, and it has two creeks running through it (one against the west side and the other against the east side. There are springs coming out of the east side. The less steep area between the two creeks where the grade ranges from 10% to 55% is geologically classified as "West Mobile Ground". (See Figure 4 of Appendix B of the Seahurst Park Master Plan). Planning and construction of a trail in this area would likely be fraught with red tape and project-threatening delays, and the need for supplemental funding. Urban hikers are harder on trails than are the hikers who go into the mountains. Many urban hikers are unaware of the damage they can do to the fragile environment in Seahurst Park. This will contribute to higher maintenance costs.

The citizens of Burien would be better served if the council members were to remove # 34 from the draft plan and spend their time looking only for win-win projects. There are 60 other projects in the "List of Possibilities" that the steering group passed on to the council for consideration. The consultant facilitator Mr. Matanovic and city planner Ms Pennington deserve some kind of a medal for getting the 17 steering group members to agree to pass this list to the council. Particularly as there was so little time and information available upon which to base an informed judgment.

RE: PROPOSED PEDESTRIAN & BICYCLE FACILITIES PLAN

Dear Honorable Mayor & Council Members:

Because of the controversy over identifying a potential trail connection to Seahurst Park from the north end of 21st Ave SW at SW 146th Street in the proposed City of Burien Pedestrian & Bicycle Facilities Plan, I solicited signatures in support of said trail from the effected neighborhood. The attached petition reflects signatures collected to date. I represent myself in writing this letter.

I understand the difficulty in making decisions when a faction of people stridently objects. Participating on the Burien Pedestrian & Bicycle Facilities Plan Citizen Steering Group, as well as being a Parks & Recreation Board Member during the Seahurst Master Plan process, I am keenly aware of the concerns of those who oppose this proposed trail. I made their concerns known during my petition drive, as well as the City's efforts that have been made to alleviate the problems that they identified. I also spoke of the Seahurst Master Plan's proposal to address safety issues surrounding the upper parking lot which would have an impact on the neighborhood adjoining the trail. They are:

- Re-configured the upper parking lot to provide more parking along the street;
- Open upper parking lot for better visibility by police patrols; and
- Possibly install surveillance camera.

This Plan's proposal is to make the trail legitimate through City ownership, safe through the creation of a 3 to 6 foot wide crushed rock path with brush cleared away for visibility, and inclusive through the support of a policy where by any of these improvements would be first discussed fully with the neighborhood. Knowing the concerns of their neighbors and understanding that the City has proposed solutions; people signed the petition in support. They also understand this is a 20 year plan that will assist the City attain funds for the needed improvements and that the trail will be a benefit to their community at large.

Children today use this trail, as did I some 45 years ago. Today, as then, it's narrow, slippery, and overgrown. It was identified during the Pedestrian & Bicycle Facilities planning process as a neighborhood asset that needed legitimizing and improving for both access and safety. Most of the 500 plus people that were involved in the Pedestrian & Bicycle Facilities Plan support the plan, which includes this trail connection. The trail will be used by the nearby children and their friends, and if improved, by the many adult residents that regularly walk in their neighborhood. Now you have a few more voices in support of keeping this trail as part of Burien's future.

Dear Honorable Mayor & Council Members:

There are many members from the steering committee that will testify to the broad community outreach we conducted during the year long planning process, the care that was taken to incorporate community comments, and the enthusiasm we witnessed as we brought this plan to the community for final public review.

I'm here tonight to focus on a single existing trail located on private property that connects the Seahurst Community with Seahurst Park. It's improvement project #34 and can be found at the north end of 21st Ave. S.W. and S.W. 146th Street. This trail is presently used by neighborhood children much like I used it 45 years ago. The proposed improvement would be a type #12 walking trail 3-6' wide with crushed rock for pedestrians only, and of coarse bring it into public ownership.

This trail first became controversial during the Seahurst Park Master planning process, which I know you are all familiar with. I sat on the Park Board at the time and know the details of the neighbors concerns. In part to balance NYBY outcry to legitimizing this trail, I collected 23 signatures within the same neighborhood who all favor of the trail. I explained the controversy, the proposed solutions both within the Seahurst Park Master Plan as well as this plan. They signed because they saw the trail as an asset to the community, one that they and their kids could use, and they were confident that any future neighborhood concerns could be worked out through an open design process guaranteed in the Pedestrian & Bicycle Facilities Plan.

I urge you tonight to think towards the future and provide the opportunity of securing this trail connection to Seahurst Park for the neighborhood so they could walk rather than drive to our beautiful shoreline park.

My name is Loran Kollmorgen.

My wife and I purchased our home at the end of 23rd Ave. SW about 40 years ago. Our house is just about the northern most residence in Seahurst.

We bought our house for three basic reasons:

first, it was the highest building lot in the neighborhood,

second, it has a reasonably nice view of Puget Sound,

but most importantly it provided safety and security for our family because it was at the end of a dead-end street.

We raised two daughters there and lived in a world that was safe and didn't have to need the help of local police to maintain any semblance of peace of mind.

We are now 70 years old. We love our house. We'd like to stay there for the 15 years the Internal Revenue Service says that we have left to live.

Like most older citizens, we have concerns regarding our safety and well-being. We have had two sets of friends, that when they were about our age, were accosted by intruders in their own homes. These incidences were many and many miles apart and they occurred in the 1980's.

The unique thing about each incidence was that the intruding hoodlums beat up each couple so severely they never completely recuperated their health. As a result we believe they died because of complications due to their beatings which led to ill health and finally to their demise.

We sincerely believe that if trails are installed in the park near our property, there is a distinct possibility that hoodlums will use the trails as an entrance to our property, burglarize or in other ways terrorize our home, steal whatever they might find worth carrying away, and worst of all, cause bodily harm that would jeopardize our health.

This is not a fantasy. Our friends truly experienced this scenario.

Sheila, my wife is no longer physically strong and would be particularly vulnerable if accosted by intruders. I must say that as a youth that I was strong as an ox and could protect myself under most circumstances. I am no longer strong, I am in pretty good physical condition, but I am no match for some of the young bucks that cause problems in our neighborhoods.

We do believe that a path in and by itself is inert and is pretty sterile. But they are attractive nuisances and I can see that a bike path would be a splendid attraction for the older teenagers riding mountain bicycles in our neighborhood. We believe that the upper reaches of the park will be a physical challenge for mountain bikers and will provide an outstanding opportunity for crime and the crime would be aimed at the closest people.... which is us and most of the people in this meeting.



How about improving the picnic areas along the north beach of the park. How about improving the seawall along the north beach of the park. How about providing more help to build the Environmental Science Center so all generations can benefit from knowledge about our seashore.

In closing, please listen to the neighbors who will be affected by the paths and simply say no. It seems to us that you owe us that respect.





Comparison of trail #34 with other trails

During the Seahurst Park Master Plan issue in the fall of 2002, The city staff and members of the council identified other trails for comparison to the proposed trail at 21st Ave SW and SW 146th Street. One was the Burke Gilman Trail in Seattle, and the other was the Indian Trail at Three Tree Point.

1. The Burke Gilman trail was cited by the city staff as a trail to which the public had taken issue with before it was developed. Following development, the trail was judged not so bad after all, but even beneficial in some ways. A half-inch report was presented to each council member. One of the council members gave me his copy during a council meeting. I read the report and found that what the council reported at the council meeting was borne out by the report.

2. The Indian Trail was identified for comparison by one of the council members on a personal basis. The council member stated that based on living next to the Indian trail for several years, there was no security problem.

Investigation indicates these are not viable comparisons to the 21st and 146th entry/signage issue.

The proposed trail at 21st and 146th is through dense vegetation, winding by necessity of the steepness of the canyon, creek, and loose earth, not visible by more than one or two homes at any vantage point – and only from backs of homes. This trail leads into a park of over 150 acres of dense underbrush and medium and tall trees, and connects with paths in the vicinity of the upper parking lot and other known problem areas. Seahurst Park is the escape route of choice for vandals and lawbreakers. This applies to vandals and lawbreakers that are familiar with the neighborhood and those not familiar with the neighborhood. For those not familiar, every few years there is an incident with police boxing in assailants in the park after they pass through this neighborhood by car. Then finding themselves boxed in by road, they leave the car and enter the park on foot. This activity is typically accompanied by one or more of: many police sirens, racing autos, the use of tracking dogs, and helicopters with search lights; leading to the apprehension of the lawbreakers.

The police have apprehended the law breakers that are more familiar with the area - often by waiting for them at known park exit points. Our police are expert at what they do – and the neighborhood appreciates it. However the residents are left with the perception that there is a increased danger associated with the increased familiarity brought by this #34 proposed trail. And as police management will tell you, perception is a cost driver for security (in addition to actual crime). Residents will tell you that much of the crime, especially vandalism and smaller-item-theft is discovered at some undetermined interval after the act, and it is not reported to the police.

The Burke Gilman Trail is essentially a reclaimed rail system. It is open because rail systems are by design quite level, basically straight with only gradual curves. Refer to the map (included in attachment A, which is from the Seattle.gov website) of this 14 mile trail as it follows streets and the former rail bed. This path is near the water level of Lake Washington and Lake Union.

The Indian Trail is quite different from the proposed #34 entry/signage proposed at 21st and 146th. The Indian Trail occupies less than one acre of public land (It is approximately a 6 foot strip that carries the water utility for residents on both sides of the trail.) As such it runs at nearly a constant elevation parallel to sealevel. The homes are very near to each other and are close as practical to the water main. Refer to Attachment B map of the Three Tree Point area and the Indian Trail. This map shows the homes in close proximity to the trail. Many of these homes use the Indian Trail as the primary entry/exit from their homes. The combined homeowner's visibility on this trail is equal or greater than it is over a typical street in front of Burien homes. Compare the Indian Trail on Attachment B to Attachment C, which shows the #34 proximity to homes. The two maps are on the same scale.

Although I have not researched a comparison with the Soos Creek trail in the Kent area, I believe you are aware that there have been several attacks in that area in the past several years. I do not know how secluded it is. It would appear to be relatively level, as the name suggests that it follows Soos Creek. There are probably no switch-backs associated with elevation changes.



Born as a Railroad

In 1885 Judge Thomas Burke, Daniel Gilman and ten other investors set out to establish a Seattle-based railroad so that the young city might win a place among major transportation centers and reap the economic benefits of trade. Their plan was to start along today's Burke-Gilman Trail route and go north to Sumas and connect with the Canadian Transcontinental line. Their Seattle, Lake Shore and Eastern Railroad, though it never got past Arlington, Washington, was a major regional line serving Puget Sound logging areas. The line was acquired by Northern Pacific in 1913 and continued in fairly heavy use until 1963. The Great Northern, Northern Pacific, and Burlington lines were merged in 1970 to become Burlington Northern Railroad. In 1971 Burlington Northern applied to abandon the line.

A Multiple Use Trail

Citizens quickly recognized the non-motorized transportation and recreational potential in the railroad line and launched a movement to acquire the right-of-way for a public biking and walking trail. Objections from residents living near the proposed trail were overcome and the City of Seattle, the University of Washington and King County cooperated in developing the route. The original 12.1 miles of the trail connecting Seattle's Gas Works Park and King County's Tracy Owen Station in Kenmore were dedicated on August 19, 1978.

The trail was recently extended west through Seattle's Fremont neighborhood to Eighth Avenue NW. The trail also reaches east to Redmond by means of the Samammish River Trail.

A Major Urban Route

The Burke-Gilman Trail is an outstanding success and has been beneficial to the neighborhoods which it passes through. The trail has become a major transportation corridor that serves thousands of commuter and recreational cyclists. It demonstrates that when the proper facilities are provided many people will chose healthy, pollution-free, non-motorized modes of travel.

The trail can at times be busy and even crowded with cyclists, walkers,

joggers and skaters. Busy periods require all users be especially watchful, cautious, and respectful of others. Fast cyclists must adjust their speed to suit the conditions or use alternative routes. All trail users must keep to the right.

Safety Code

Go Slow

Keep Right

Respect Others

Horses and motorized vehicles are not allowed on the Burke-Gilman Trail.

Trail Etiquette

Bicyclists - Bicyclists should yield to pedestrians and give an audible warning when passing others on the trail. All riders should ride at a safe speed and avoid pacelines and pack riding. Fast cyclists should use alternative routes; some routes are suggested on the Seattle Bicycling Guide Map. Wear a bicycle helmet.

Pedestrians - Walkers, runners, and skaters should watch for other trail users and listen for audible signals to allow faster users to pass safely. When the trail is congested, form a single line to the right. Dogs should be on a leash (maximum length of 8 feet) and dog walkers are required to remove pet feces from the trail.



EXISTING INDIAN TRAIL PROXIMITY TO HOMES.



A review of the attendance was conducted to determine whether some neighborhoods were more represented than others. Below is a description of the approach used and the findings:

Approach and Findings:

1. Each name and corresponding street address was copied from each of the public meeting sign-in sheets into a list in a computer spreadsheet for sorting and grouping.
2. The lists were then merged and sorted by name.
3. Two columns were added with the headings:
 - a. Comment – this column is used to identify:
 - 1) City Personnel,
 - 2) Non-resident, and
 - 3) A repeat of a resident's name
 - b. Neighborhood group

City Personnel consists of staff and council. *Non-resident* is based on address given on the sign-in sheet. *A repeat of a resident's name* is denoted in the comment column as "2nd or more time" to indicate those attendees that signed in at more than one meeting.

4. The merged list was then sorted by the comment column. There are 147 entries in the comment column. This indicates there are a total of 219 different resident's names on the composite sign-in list when multiple attendances and city personnel are removed. (366 minus 147 = 219.) Of the 219, no address was given for 39 of these individuals. Multiple attendances are expected, as there were progressive meeting activities held for the public by the city. This progressive activities consisted of a First Round (five meetings) in which a "list of possibilities" was solicited, and a Second Round (another five meetings) during which list of possibilities was refined (by combining and adding to) and categorized. Next a December 4th 2003 meeting was held at which the public was instructed to review the list of the projects and make a brief verbal comment. And finally the draft plan was made available for public review on March 18, 2004, and approval or disapproval was requested on a form provided.

5. Next the list was sorted by the column headed "Neighborhood Groups". Two significant size neighborhood groupings are noted:

- Three Tree Point, and
- West 152nd (SW 152nd St West of Ambaum).

Because an e-mail address or a PO Box was sometimes used in lieu of a street address, street addresses was not determined 39 of the individuals who signed in. (Continued)

REVIEW OF BIKE/PED PUBLIC MEETING SIGN-IN SHEETS

Observation:

#1. There were more people at these meetings than those that signed in. For example, staff and consultants rarely signed in. Many on the Steering Committee apparently did not sign in, particularly if they had signed in at an earlier meeting.

#2. With regard to Three Tree Point, and SW152nd West of Ambaum, these two neighborhood groups appear to have expressed themselves well at the public meetings. In the earlier meetings with respect to the Three Tree Point area, it was common to hear a phrase such as “preserve the character of the neighborhood” and “there isn’t enough room to ensure safety of pedestrians and bikers”. At the final public meeting on March 18, 2004, many of the West 152nd group expressed themselves well. Apparently several of the SW 152nd group had heard of the plans for their neighborhood only recently, and many comments were made about the Bike/Ped plan for their neighborhood.

#3. There were very few residents in attendance who had objected to the proposed Seahurst Park Master Plan entry/signage at 21st Ave SW and 146th in 2002. (This now corresponds to #34 in the Bike/Ped Plan.) Very few comments were made by any of the 2002 objecting residents. I heard only two brief comments. (Review of the meeting notes taken by the consultant and by the meetings summary, three comments were made – perhaps one of these was made by letter?) The description of what took place in 2002 was presented by the #34 advocates. #34 was not identified for potential inclusion in the plan until December 4, 2003. At the December 4th meeting, only one person – very near the end of the *around the room* comments – made a comment. That comment was to briefly express disbelief that #34 was to be included in the list of possibilities after all of the citizen concerns expressed in 2002. After December 4th there were no more public meetings until after the steering committee had finalized the draft plan - after the draft plan was presented. At the next public meeting on March 18, 2004, I spoke up at the tail end of the meeting and presented a large handout to the city staff and the consultants (this is the same handout given to the council members at the May 17th Council meeting. The residents who signed the 2002 petitions and attended the Seahurst School meeting may feel it is unnecessary to reiterate their position on this park entry/signage at 21st and 146th. I believe that, as of this writing, many of these residents feel that the city will not include #34 in the adopted Bike/Ped Plan because of the 2002 issue over the Seahurst Park Master Plan.

SUMMARY OF PUBLIC INPUT: FIRST ROUND COMMUNITY MEETINGS

CONTEXT: The Burien Comprehensive Plan (1997) contains goals and policies intended to fulfill the Burien Vision to be a community that (1) integrates vehicles, pedestrians, bicycles, and transit and (2) has natural open spaces, parks, paths, and trails. The Comprehensive Plan specifically calls for a plan that addresses the development of an integrated long-range plan for pedestrian, bicycle, and recreation trails: the *Burien Pedestrian and Bicycle Facilities Plan*.

PROCESS OVERVIEW: The community planning process began in spring 2003 and is scheduled for completion in May 2004. A steering group of representatives from different neighborhoods and community groups was created to assist with the process. Additional public input includes two rounds of community meetings (five meetings each round, in May and September 2003) and two community-wide meetings (scheduled for December 2003 and February 2004).

FIRST ROUND COMMUNITY MEETINGS: The first phase of community input is complete. Over 200 people attended the May meetings. Public input was gathered by recording ideas expressed at the meetings, analyzing maps created by small groups at each meeting (24 maps were created), and through comment forms distributed at the meetings and via the City of Burien website. Additional public input will be gathered throughout the project.

OVERVIEW OF FIRST ROUND FINDINGS: Community input indicated great commitment to create a pedestrian/bicycle/trail system aligned with the following principles:

- Ensure safety in all proposals
- Promote safe walking and biking routes around schools
- Create connected North-South and East-West routes
- Connect to other communities, parks, existing local and regional trails, schools, commercial centers, churches, recreational facilities, transit, etc.
- Consider topography and other natural constraints

Additional comments in a variety of fields were also presented (for example):

- Maintain trails: re-open existing overgrown trails; turn informal trails into regular trails
- Develop facilities that separate bikes from pedestrians
- Other: please refer to the more detailed record of input on the City website

SPECIFIC RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC (Note: not all citizens agreed with all listed recommendations—these are examples of some of the most common comments. Please refer to the more detailed record of input on the City website for additional commentary. All commentary, not just the summary, will be reviewed for the next stages of the planning process.):

- North-South Routes
 - Primarily bicycle facility requested
 - Ambaum Blvd was the most suggested location
 - Des Moines Mem Dr, 4th Ave SW, and 1st Ave S were also repeatedly suggested
- East-West Routes
 - Pedestrian/bicycle facilities most commonly suggested
 - 152nd St was most commonly suggested; also: 160th, 136th, 146th, 156th, 128th Streets
- Internal Connections
 - Connections to the downtown core and surrounding schools and parks
- Nature/Recreational Trails
 - Connect parks: Seahurst and Salmon Creek Ravine; Branson and Seahurst Park
 - Mark and maintain trails in Three Tree Point area
 - Multi-use trail surrounding Moshier Park
 - Connect to Seola Park
