CITY OF BURIEN ISSUES PROCLAMATION TO RECOGNIZE THE HIGHLINE BEARS

BURIEN, WASH. – The City of Burien has issued a proclamation honoring the Highline Bears for bringing semi-professional baseball to the Highline community. Council members voted to support the proclamation at last night’s regularly-scheduled City Council meeting.

The proclamation reads, in part: The City Council of the City of Burien, Washington honors the Highline Bears for bringing semi-professional baseball to the Highline community. We encourage our residents and businesses to support the team and we wish them much success.

The Highline Bears are a semi-professional baseball team which is a part of the Pacific International League (a non-profit organization), and is sanctioned by the National Baseball Congress. The Highline Bears players and coaches strive to be role models for local kids and aim to bring the community together through the game of baseball, a community-oriented, family-friendly and team-first sport. The Highline Bears’ home games are played locally at Steve Cox Memorial Park and tickets are affordable (\$3 for adults and free for kids 12 and under). The Highline Bears 2015 season started on May 30th and ends on August 2nd.
