**Downtown Mobility Study-Parking Recommendations Discussion:**

Dan Trimble, Economic Development Manager, leads a discussion on parking recommendations from transportation consultant Fehr & Peers. Suggestions include better leveraging of existing parking supply, revising parking standards, modifying time limits on parking from two to three hours, and restriping back-in angled parking. Also discussed was how Burien's parking requirements compare to other Puget Sound Communities, and Burien's existing public parking occupancy/utilization.

The final report for the Downtown Mobility Study, including parking recommendations, will be presented to Council in July.

**Discover Burien Report:**

Andrea Reay provides an update. The executive director position remains open and those duties are currently being split amongst staff. Andrea returned part-time as a consultant and will handle business development along with media and public relations, and a Community Outreach Coordinator has been brought on board.

Relay for Life is Saturday, June 11, and will be held in Burien Town Square Park; the 2016 Highline Historical Garden Tour is Saturday, June 11; the Burien Wild Strawberry Festival is June 18-19, and the Father's Day Car and Motorcycle show is June 19.
