(Entrance at the corner of building at S 130th Pl. and 1st Ave S.)

DETAILS:

- Maximum capacity of 30.
- Drop-ins welcome. Safe and confidential.
- Separate areas for men, women, and families.
- Snacks/food provided.
- No pets allowed.
- The shelter is an emergency, mat-on-floor shelter operated by Catholic Community Services.

## KING COUNTY SEVERE WEATHER SHELTER

LOCATION: King County Administration Building, 500 4th Avenue, Seattle, WA 98104

(Downtown Seattle)

OPEN: 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
